



Pembroke Dock Community Web Project (Overview)

The project was started October 2002 and has already outgrown the original specification, In May of 2003 more web space was added, the project is now published on three interlinked sites at www.pembrokedock.org, www.pembroke-dock.co.uk, www.thedock.org.uk

The site has directories, updated by volunteer/groups in the community and the Town Council Offices. Web input and update for parts of the project will, after training be instigated by volunteers utilising their own computers at home or within community groups. To maintain the sustainability of the project Training sessions were held regularly by the volunteer IT team at the Town Council Offices we have logged in excess of 74 hours of web project training all of which is ongoing. We are continually adding to the project and are in dialogue with several other groups in the community who are very keen to be included. One of the main aims was create a sustainable local community network. We have incorporated several of the sites, first instigated under the PAVS IT Project; these sited now utilize the interactive links and information sections housed on Pembroke Dock Community Web Project thereby creating a further networking experience.

To maintain the growth of the web project the committee is also exploring various ongoing financing options, the project is testing a sponsorship plan, which would allow the local business to sponsor pages, and an e-mail shot function both based on a graduated donation scale. We also encourage other community groups to make enquiries as to the viability of funding their own part of the web project. To further enhance the web projects sustainability, interactivity in the form of a Town Calendar has been introduced

This will as it grows be a great way to simulate networking between all participating groups, not only the voluntary sectors but also the local authority, local private business and the community. To enhance the project's sustainability the site will become more and more interactive; the latest addition is a bulletin board, designed to function as a community forum.
